- i) Statement that when lockable castors/wheels are fitted, they shall be locked when the changing unit is in use.
- j) Weight of the child for which the product is intended: 12 months, up to 11kg.
- k) Means of identifying the product e.g. model number.
- l) The name, registered trade name or registered trademark of either the manufacturer or distributor.
- m) Statement any additional or replacement parts shall only be obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.
- n) Statement not to use the changing unit when a part is broken, torn or missing.
